**A complete gear check is required for all in-water participation. The Staff must be able to visually check the condition of all required (Full Skin) Gear.

Full OCEAN Skin Gear (FOSG) 3R's. Full Skin Gear is full wetsuit (recommended 7 mil.), mask, fins, and a snorkel. We highly recommend sturdy booties with open heel fins to provide foot protection. A hood and gloves are also recommended for comfort and safety.
